Branch Root Expression & High Forage Yield Potential

Premium alfalfa variety selected for a high expression of the branch root feature giving growers the ability to produce in poorer, wet soils. This variety is also protected by a broad disease resistance base.

Agronomic Characteristics:

- Disease Resistance Index: 39/40
- Fall Dormancy: 4.2
- Winter Survival: 1.8
- Average recovery after harvest
- Excellent Forage Yield
- Very Good Forage Quality
- Sunken Crown Placement
- 20% Multi-leaf Expression
- Branch/Tap Root

High Disease Resistance To:

- Bacterial Wilt
- Fusarium Wilt
- Verticillium Wilt
- Anthracnose
- Phytophthora Root Rot
- Aphanomyces Root Rot (Race 1&2)
- Some Resistance to Aphanomyces Root Rot Race 3

Keys to Establishment:

- Seed at least 15 lbs/acre into a smooth yet firm seedbed
- Planting depth should not go deeper than a half-inch
